- 4 29, 1906 (34 Stat. 598), as amended by the Act of May
- 5 9, 1918 (40 Stat. 377), as further amended by section
- 6 10 of the Act of May 25, 1992 (17 Stat. 166; U. S. C.,
- 7 1934 edition, title 8, sec. 377), as further amended by the
- 8 Δct of May 16, 1938, is further amended by adding "that
- 9 notwithstanding any provisions in any of the existing statutes
- 10 to the contrary, any person born in Puerto Rico on or after
- 11 April 11, 1899, is ipso facto, by birth, hereby declared to
- 12 be a citizen of the United States, irrespective of the citizen-
- 13 ship of the parents."
