A BILL

Declaring that all citizens of Porto Rico shall be citizens of the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That all citizens of Porto Rico, as defined by section seven
4 of the Act of April twelfth, nineteen hundred, "temporarily
5 to provide revenues and a civil government for Porto Rico,
6 and for other purposes," are hereby declared and shall be
7 deemed and held to be citizens of the United States.
