A BILL

To amend the Act of June 27, 1934, entitled "An Act to amend the Act of March 2, 1917, entitled "An Act to provide a civil government for Puerto Rico, and for other purposes," "

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That children born in Puerto Rico of parents who retained
4 their allegiance to the Crown of Spain as provided in the
5 Act of Congress of April 12, 1900, shall not be deemed to
6 be citizens, subjects, or nationals of a foreign power within
7 the meaning of the Act of Congress of June 27, 1934:
8 *Provided, however,* That unless such children born in Puerto
9 Rico have been found to have become subjects or nationals
10 of a foreign country by having renounced their allegiance
11 to the United States they shall be considered and declared to
12 be citizens of the United States.
