AN ACT

Preserving the nationality of a person born in Puerto Rico who resides for five years in a foreign state.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
That the Act approved October 14, 1940 (54 Stat. 1137 1174), is hereby amended by adding a new section to be
known as section 406A, and to read as follows:

6 "Subsection (c) of section 404 shall have no application 7 to a person born in Puerto Rico, except a person who has 8 been a citizen of some foreign country and who thereafter 9 acquired citizenship in the United States by naturalization."
